- Small microwavable bowl Tip: Use a non-white, clear glass bowl.

- Timer Metal fork

Tip: If you don't have a microwave, heat water on high on stove top for 1 ¹/₂ min until small bubbles form at the bottom of the pot. Use a thermometer to ensure water is 150°F. Pour water into the bowl.

INSTRUCTIONS

C FITTING FEATURES

Look at your snore aid and find the fitting features that will help you get a good fit.

- CENTERING MARK Helps center the snore aid from left to right
- **B** FRONT BUMPER Indicates where to position teeth from front to back
- **G** MOLAR GUIDES Fits the occlusal groove of your molars and centers them on the snore aid
- D ADVANCEMENT STOPS Advances lower jaw up to 7 positions

FINS Engages the upper tray with the lower tray to hold the jaw forward

3-NIGHT TRIAL PERIODS

UPPER TRAY





• If snoring persists, adjust both Advancement Stops forward to Position 1 and wear for another 3 nights. Continue these trial adjustment periods until snoring reduces or stops.

HOW IT WORKS



Snore Aid holds jaw in neutral position or advances forward to open airway until snoring is reduced.

PRACTICE FITTING

Do not adjust the ADVANCEMENT STOPS yet.

Practice fitting the UPPER TRAY and LOWER TRAY to your teeth before heating and fitting.

- 1) While looking in a mirror, place the UPPER TRAY in your mouth and align the **CENTERING MARK** with the middle of your two front teeth.
- 2) Then place the **FITTING TRAY** over the UPPER TRAY.

3) Once in place, lightly bite down and feel the MOLAR **GUIDES** engage with your upper molars.

4) Repeat steps 1-3 to practice fitting the LOWER TRAY.


- Always insert the Upper Tray before the Lower Tray.
- Always remove the Lower Tray before the Upper Tray.
- Each time you remove the trays, begin by popping them off the front teeth first.

DID YOU GET A GOOD FIT?

- It is normal for your snore aid to feel slightly loose while removing it after the initial fit. It will tighten up after 24 hours.
- If you find that your snore aid fits too tightly upon reinserting it after 24 hours, rinse it with hot tap water to allow it to relax for a more comfortable fit.

- If your snore aid has an uneven or peeling area you would like removed, you may trim it using kitchen shears.

F FITTING UPPER TRAY

- 1) While looking in a mirror, use two hands to place the tray under your **upper** teeth, while centering your front teeth behind the FRONT BUMPER.
- 2) Lightly bite down. Use your fingers and tongue to hold the tray in place.
- 3) Immediately place the **FITTING TRAY** over the upper tray and bite down. Use your fingers and thumbs to press and pinch the fitting tray on the front and back of every tooth, including your back molars.
- 4) Close your lips and create suction to form the material to your teeth. Hold the trays in your mouth for a full 4 minutes before removing.





CLEANING & STORAGE

- To clean your snore aid, rinse it with cool water or mouthwash. Do not soak. Avoid hot water.
- For further cleaning, brush it with a soft toothbrush and toothpaste.
- Dry thoroughly and store in your provided case. Store at room temperature.

G REMOVING

- To remove the trays from your teeth, begin by popping it off the front teeth first.
- To remove the upper tray from the fitting tray, start at one end and push your finger between them until they separate.





H FITTING LOWER TRAY

- Repeat steps E and F to fit the LOWER TRAY to your lower teeth.
- Do not reuse the old water in the bowl.
- Place the lower tray in the hot water with the FINS facing down.
- When pressing material around your lower teeth, be sure to reach below the FINS along the back molars.
